

IME-BECAS 2017

CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

From August 15th to October 5th

Mexico's Ministry of Foreign Affairs, through its Consular Network in the United States and the **Institute of Mexicans Abroad (IME)**, calls on educational institutions and non-profit educational organizations interested in IME-Becas to submit application proposals to get financial support for Mexican and Mexican origin students enrolled in their academic plans under the following modalities:

1. **HIGHER EDUCATION¹**
2. **ADULT EDUCATION²**



GUIDELINES

- Educational institutions and organizations (Universities, Community Colleges) may apply for **IME-BECAS** financial support through the Mexican Consulate nearest to their registered address.
- Please find in **anex 1** the amount assigned to each consulate by the Government of Mexico.
- Only institutions or organizations willing to commit themselves to obtain additional funds, which at least match those requested from the corresponding consulate, will be taken into consideration.
- Incomplete applications or those received after the closing date of this call, will not be accepted. For mailed proposals, the date of postmark will be considered and not the date of reception in the consular offices.

Applicants are responsible to make sure that the consular representation received their request.

² Literacy: elementary and middle school, GED or HiSET exams, computer training, job training, y and English as a Second Language (ESL)

REQUIREMENTS

- 1) The following documents must be attached to the application form:
 - Curriculum Vitae of the person in charge of managing the funds requested from the Mexican Government through IME Becas in the organization / institution as well as the activities involved in the Program.
 - Copy of the organization / institution **“bylaws”**
- 2) Include a proposal with the following information:
 - Mission of the organization / educational institution.
 - In no more than three pages, please describe:
 - The goals to be achieved, anticipating the results, the procedures to assess the progress of objectives and its contributions to the educational development of Mexican immigrants.
 - The plans and projects to accomplish the set goals with IME Becas financial resources and matching funds, as well as the methods used to assess the progress of met project tasks.
 - Other funds received and anticipated by the institution / organization in order to achieve the objectives of the financial support and other related activities.
 - Educational institutions, which offer financial support, must commit themselves to use at least 80%, of the total of IME Becas resources plus the matching funds to benefit students of Mexican origin
 - Please include a detailed budget analysis of the expenditures proposed by the applicant institution or organization, including a brief statement describing the purpose of such expenditures. The budget should also indicate how financial support will be distributed among students, coordinators or teachers, and when those will be delivered.
 - Institutions and organizations which participated on IME Becas in the immediately previous cycle, must present the corresponding report of results.

Application deadline: October 5th, 2017

SELECTION PROCESS

Each Mexican Consulate will verify that all application forms meet the requirements of this call. A **Local Committee**, composed of at least three distinguished persons from the consular district involved in education and community work, will select the institutions and organizations to be taken into consideration.

- 1) Institutions and organizations offering to match the amount requested from IME-Becas will be privileged. This means that, through other financial sources, they will contribute to fundraise the project with equal or higher amounts.
- 2) Regarding community organizations involved in adult education, the Local Committee may consider the costs of operation (teacher payment, infrastructure) as equivalent to matching funds, upon explicit request.
- 3) Only those institutions and organizations, which comply with the goals and guidelines, stated in this call, will be considered.
- 4) According to the selected modality, (higher education, adult education), the number of Mexicans or persons of Mexican origin benefited will be taken into consideration.***
- 5) To determine the amount of the financial support to be granted to each institution /organization, they must present a written commitment about the matching funds they will provide.

DISTRIBUTION OF FUNDS

IME allocates the funds taking into account the size of the consular district of each representation, the number of strategic partners and the population served. It also considers prioritizing areas with underprivileged or vulnerable communities.

PUBLICATION OF RESULTS

The **Institute for Mexicans Abroad** will publish the **results** on **October 19th, 2017**.
Consulates will **hand over the funds** during **October and November 2017**.
